WILLS AND TRUSTS: The preparation of wills and of revocable and irrevocable trusts.

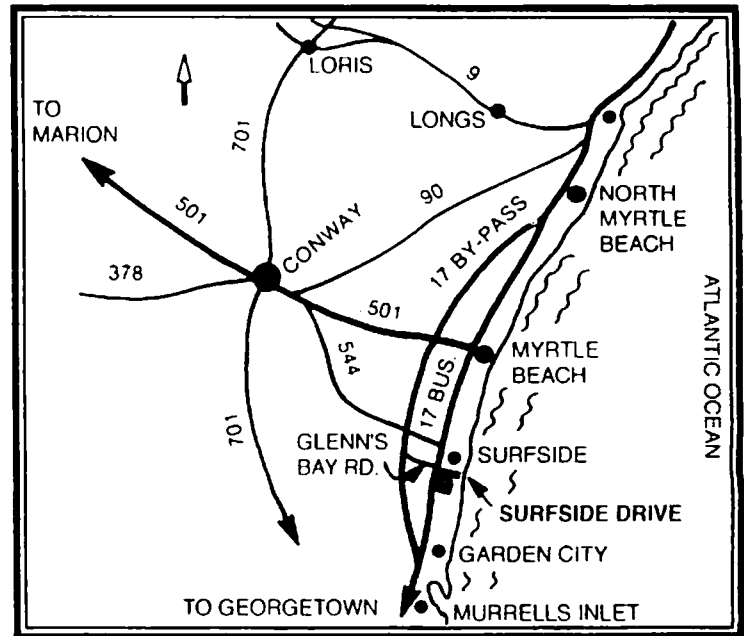

Our Location

We are easily accessible to you at 15 Highway 17 South, Surfside Beach, located on the southern corner of Highway 17 and Surfside Drive. If you are coming by way of Highway 17 By-pass, turn on Glenn's Bay Road and proceed to the intersection at Highway 17 Business. When you cross this intersection, Glenn's Bay Road becomes Surfside Drive. Make an immediate right turn after coming through the intersection, our office is located right on the corner. If you are coming South on Highway 17 Business, turn left onto Surfside Drive and make an immediate right into the Floyd Center where our office is located. If you are coming North on Highway 17 Business, make a right into our office just before you reach the intersection of Highway 17 Business and Surfside Drive. Attorney - Client

The relationship between a client and his or her attorney requires complete trust and confidence between them. This is usually not a problem. You should understand, however, you are not obligated to retain our firm and we are not obligated to take your case if we do not feel comfortable with each other.

Your work will be done in complete confidence, and no one will ever learn from us that you came to our office.

We will try to keep you informed about the progress of your work as we go along. Sometimes you will hear from us by telephone, and sometimes by a memorandum or an information copy of a letter we send out or receive. Feel free to call with questions, if you have not heard or do not understand. Regardless of the type of case, each one is important to us.



Our Work

When you retain our firm, there should be a clear understanding between us about the extent of the work we are authorized to do. We will discuss the types of legal remedies or legal work required by the situation and the estimated time and legal expense involved. It is a good time to be practical. If, as the work progresses, there are unexpected developments which result in a longer time period or greater expense than anticipated, we will tell you when we recognize this.



Fees

In most cases, our fees are based upon the time and responsibility involved. Some work is done on an hourly basis. For other matters, a flat fee is appropriate. Some cases, such as personal injury litigation, are handled on a contingent fee basis, whereby the fee for legal services is a percentage of the amount of money obtained for you.

You should discuss the fee arrangement with the attorney during your first conference at our law firm. In some matters, he or she will be able to give you an estimate of the fee. In lengthy matters, our fee will be billed periodically; in other matters, the fee is payable upon completion of the work.

DISBURSEMENTS: The work we do for you may require us to make disbursements on your behalf in addition to our legal services. Sometimes the estimated disbursements are payable in advance. Sometimes they are billed periodically.

RETAINERS: In many cases, our office policy requires an advance payment, known as a retainer, toward the fee. These advance fee payments are deposited in our trust account and are paid over to us periodically as your work progresses.
